The *Clay Shooting* Classic shoot celebrates its 20th anniversary over 6-9 June 2012 and introduces a brand new category: the Gamekeepers' Classic

Who is the best shot on your estate? Sort out the argument once and for all at the inaugural Gamekeepers' Classic clay pigeon shoot, to be held on Wednesday 6 June as part of *Clay Shooting* and E.J. Churchill's Sporting Classic 2012.

Not only can you demonstrate your shooting prowess, but it is also a fantastic chance to meet keepers from all over the country and catch up with old friends. Whether you enter on your own or as part of a team from your estate (three per team, at least two of which must work for the estate), it's sure to be a date for the social calendar as well as some friendly competition.

The event takes place on the West Wycombe Estate in Buckinghamshire, by kind permission of Sir Edward Dashwood – a mad-keen game shooter himself! The Classic is run by our sister magazine *Clay Shooting* in partnership with E.J. Churchill, the renowned gunmaker, shooting ground, and sporting agency.

Guns will tackle the courses in squads of six, buttoning and scoring each other – so expect some friendly banter during the day. And when all the shooting's done, you can sit back, relax and enjoy the free hog roast, sponsored by *Modern Gamekeeping*.

The normal entry fee is £84, but we are offering you the chance to enter the Gamekeepers' Classic for just £49, and shoot a world class course for a fraction of the cost. Running alongside the Services Classic, it promises to be a cracking day, and there are prizes too – BASC will be sponsoring the High Gun prize of £250 for the top gamekeeper, and Promatic International has donated a Superhawk single-stack clay pigeon trap worth £750 for the highest estate team score. *Modern Gamekeeping* will also provide a prize for the highest-scoring non-keeper who is shooting with friends in an estate team.

The Classic is famous for its challenging but entertaining targets, and this year will be no different. There will be two courses, each with 75 birds over 14 stands, ensuring that shooters' skills in judging speed, angle and distance are put to the test.

With the help of traps from Promatic, clays from CCI International, and ATVs from Polaris, the Gamekeepers' Classic is set to be a highlight of the gamekeeper's year – and a chance to sort out who really is the best shot on your estate. So get your entries in now to guarantee your places, and get practicing! ■
