Clay Shooting

All of our Clay Shooting takes place at the award winning E. J. Churchill Shooting Ground under the supervision of our first-class instructors. Shooting takes place in teams of up to 6 people and each team has their own instructor who will look after them for the duration of the event. We want you to have fun; we do not pretend to be able to teach someone everything about shooting on their first visit but we do ensure that everyone hits plenty of targets and, with our extensive shooting layouts we can challenge the expert as well as flatter the novice. Low recoil cartridges specially loaded for E.J Churchill are used for all novices to ensure that only memories (not bruises) remain!



Archery

Archery provides a welcome change of pace from some of our more adrenaline fuelled activities. Skill, fine judgement and a cool head are needed for this ancient sport and there is nothing quite like hitting the bullseye for the first time. Our experienced archers will give your guests expert one to one tuition, archery bows and all safety equipment required for your guests to gain a firsthand experience of this classic country sport.



Apaches

Apaches are the fastest and most exhilarating activity West Wycombe has to offer. These 750cc karts feature a 6 speed sequential gearbox and reach speeds of up to 100 mph as they race around our rally course! Due to the speedy nature of these machines a qualified instructor is by your side at all times to make sure you get the most out of this experience (and encourage you to put your foot down!)



Pilots

A unique machine that has a 400cc motor cross bike engine and a racing car chasis, hand controls and a full roll cage. After a technique and safety briefing each driver has practice laps to get used to the machine and course. After practice each driver competes in a time trial. What a fun and very exciting activity.



Powerturn Racing

Why not try a driving activity with a difference! These zippy little buggies are controlled by two guests – one in charge of going right and one in charge of going left! As you can imagine this creates a rather interesting and hilarious driving experience.



You and your partner need to work together to direct your powerturn around the course in the fastest time possible.

Hovercraft

Even for those that are a dab hand at motor sport, hovercraft racing is a somewhat unique experience. They handle like no other machine and as they hover above the ground cornering is a tricky business. The skills required to drive the craft are good balance, fine judgement and forward thinking. These are different enough from any other form of land-based racing to put everyone on a level playing field from the start. We can guarantee you will have great fun!



Off-Road Driving

This is an event for team players who feel able to put their trust in their driver on some hair-raising terrain. Teams are thoroughly briefed by their instructors and given the dos and don'ts of off-roading. Then it's all aboard for a practice lap with your instructor at the wheel. Having only seen the course once, team members will have to negotiate our short but tricky off-road course. This is not a spectator sport as everyone is in the vehicle together and can give vocal support (or pleas to be allowed out) to their driver.



Quad Biking

Life in the fast lane starts here. Our quad bikes are user-friendly 125 Yamaha's and are fully automatic with hand controls. Therefore you don't need any previous experience to be able to use them. After your initial briefing on the machines, guests are issued with crash helmets and overalls if wet. Gentle practice is the order of the day to start with and once everyone has mastered the basics the serious competition begins! This can either be in the form of a time trail around our landscaped wooded track or a safari around the main woods with points added or deducted for being able to negotiate the various natural obstacles that you and your instructors find on the way.



Trials Car (Hill Climb)

These lightweight kit cars are rear wheel driven to maximise their hill climbing capability. With "fiddle" brakes for each of the driving wheels giving maximum traction on the slippery, tree covered slope. This exhilarating activity will challenge even the most experienced driver as you try and tackle the seemingly impossible slopes.
