

GET OUTDOORS AND ENJOY A SAFE VISIT TO E.J. CHURCHILL.

With the recent announcement from the Government regarding the new Tier system, we wanted to write to you regarding these new government restrictions.

Your health and well-being, as well as the health and well-being of our staff is our highest priority. Therefore, we would like to take this opportunity to explain how the new guidance affects E.J. Churchill.

If you already have a booking with us and the new rules will affect your visit, please contact Swinton@ejchurchill.com.

If you are joining us from a Very High-Risk Area: (Tier 3)

Currently people from very high-risk areas are being advised to not travel outside of their area. Should this apply to you and you have an upcoming booking with us, please get in touch.

If you are joining us from a High-Risk Area: (Tier 2)

Shooters can still socialise outdoors in groups of up to 6. If you are joining us from more than one household, you will be unable to dine indoors. We encourage you to use the outdoor hospitality areas and use the outdoor seating.

If you are joining us from a Medium Risk area: (Tier 1)

The 'Rule of 6' is in effect. You are able to dine and socialise together in groups of up to 6.

Business meetings and events of up to 30 people indoors are allowed in Covid-19 secure venues. The rule of six does not apply to work, education and training activities.

Outlined below are the standard procedures in place in relation to all guests and E.J. Churchill members visiting our shooting grounds.

FACE COVERINGS



Face coverings must be worn in the lodge at all times and we recommend keeping face coverings on outside of the lodge as well. Please note that we have a limited number of face coverings available to purchase in store.

SOCIAL DISTANCING



Please maintain a social distance of one metre or more where possible.

HAND SANITISERS



Hand sanitisers are available throughout the lodge and across the shooting ground, as well as hand washing facilities inside the lodge.

PAYMENT



Whilst we are accepting cash, please choose contactless and cashless payment options if possible.

TRACK & TRACE



NHS Track & Trace QR code has been set up, with scannable codes placed both inside and outside of the lodge, please ensure you scan this while visiting.

LESSONS & CADDIED ROUNDS



We are running our full offering of shooting practice and tuition. Our instructors and caddies will all wear face coverings during your session. If you need to borrow a club gun, these are cleaned and sanitised between each client and we also recommend the use of gloves. If you have any special requirements that we need to be aware of please ask at the time of booking.
